
Gathering Rite on the Word of God

M: I have more insight than all my teachers,


C: for I meditate on your statutes.

Blessed Jesus, at Your Word




M: All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,


Blessed Jesus, at Your Word

THE WORD

FIRST LESSON Amos 6:1-7

Woe to you who are complacent in Zion, you who feel secure on Mount Samaria, you distinguished people of the leading nation, to whom the house of Israel comes.

² Travel to Kalneh and look.

Go from there to Hamath Rabbah, and go down to Gath of the Philistines.

Are you better than those kingdoms?

Are their territories greater than your territory?

SECOND LESSON Hebrews 13:1-6

We believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church.


We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.


SERMON Luke 16:19-31

 19 "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen, living in luxury every day. 20 A beggar named Lazarus had been laid at his gate. Lazarus was covered with sores and 21 longed to be fed with what fell from the rich man's table. Besides this, the dogs also came and licked his sores. 22 Eventually the beggar died, and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. 23 In hell, $^{[a]}$ where he was in torment, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham far away and Lazarus at his side. 24 He called out and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me! Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in misery in this flame.'

- ²⁵ "But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, and Lazarus received bad things. But now he is comforted here, and you are in misery. ²⁶ Besides all this, a great chasm has been set in place between us and you, so that those who want to cross from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us.'
- ²⁷ "He said, 'Then I beg you, father, send him to my father's home, ²⁸ because I have five brothers—to warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'
- ²⁹ "Abraham said, 'They have Moses and the Prophets. Let them listen to them.'
- ³⁰ "No, father Abraham,' he said, 'but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.'
- ³¹ "Abraham replied to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.'"

Therefore, with all the saints on earth and hosts of heaven, we praise your holy name and join their glorious song:




WORDS OF INSTITUTION
