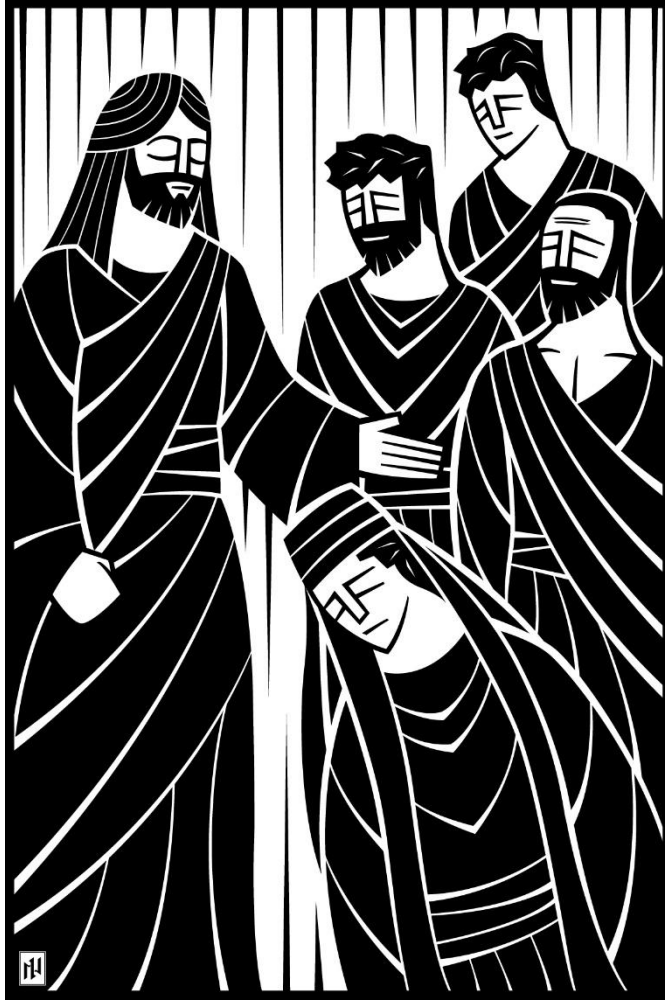

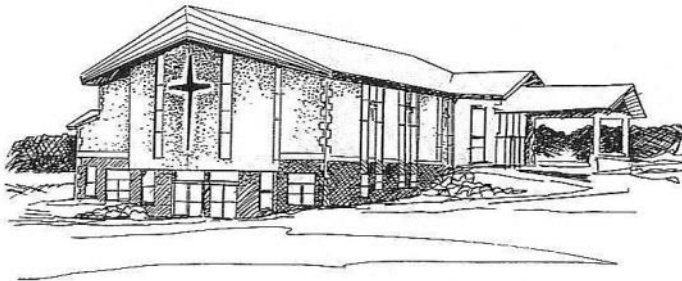

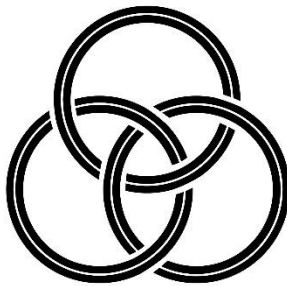

FIRST LESSON

Deuteronomy 10:12-22

¹² So now, Israel, what is the LORD your God asking of you but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him and to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ¹³ to keep the commandments of the LORD and his statutes that I am commanding you today for your own good.

¹⁴ Indeed, the heavens and the heaven of heavens, the earth and everything that is on it— these belong to the LORD your God. ¹⁵ Still, the LORD attached himself to your fathers, loved them, and he chose their descendants after them (that's you!) from all peoples, as it is today.

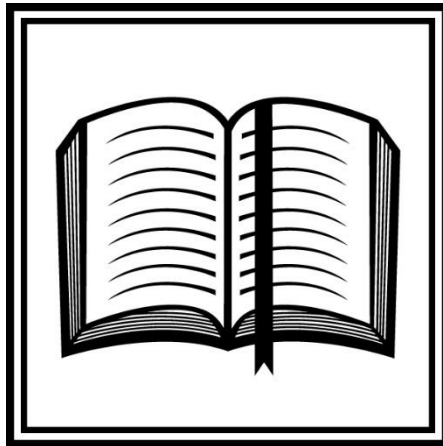

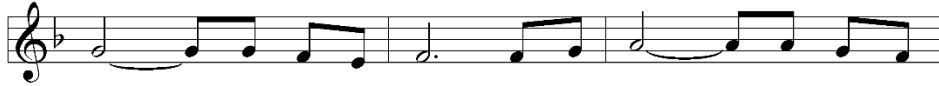

SERMON

Luke 18:18-30

¹⁸ *A certain ruler asked Jesus, “Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?”*

¹⁹ *Jesus asked him, “Why do you call me good? No one is good, except one—God. ²⁰ You know the commandments: ‘You shall not commit adultery. You shall not murder. You shall not steal. You shall not give false testimony. Honor your father and mother.’”*

²¹ *“I have kept all these since I was a child,” he said.*

²² *When Jesus heard this, he said to him, “You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me.”*

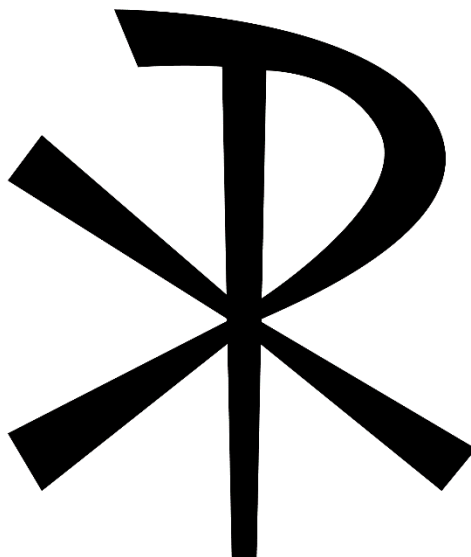
