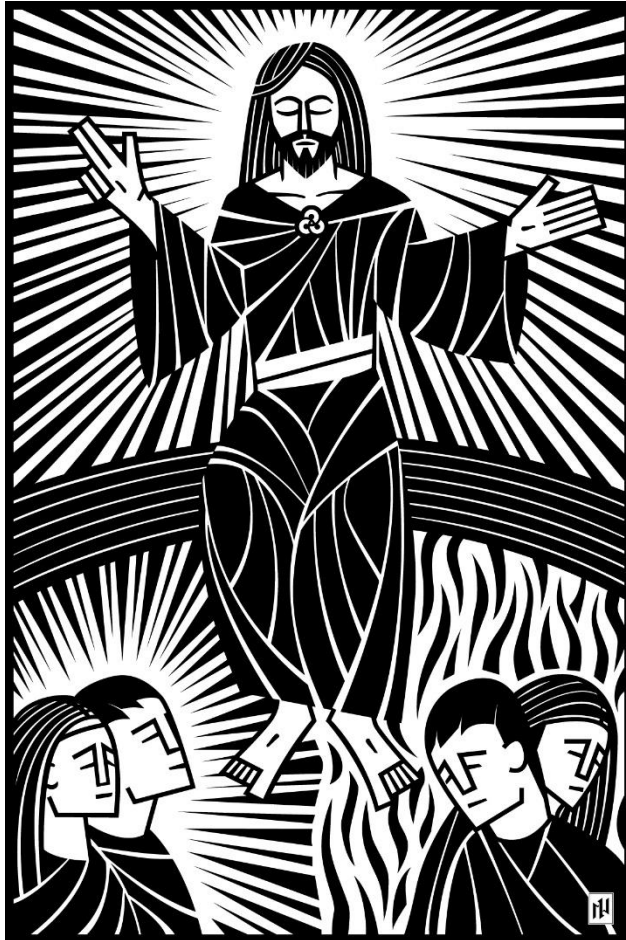

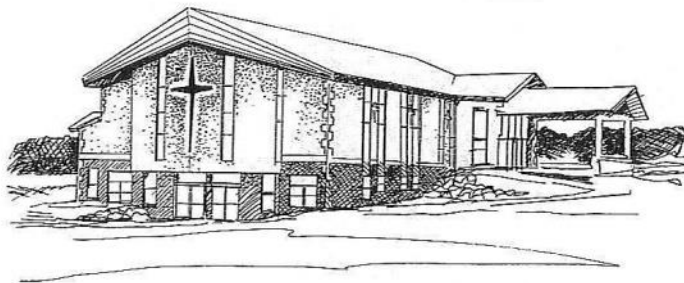

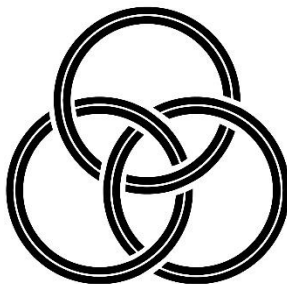
**PRAYER OF THE DAY**

## THE WORD

### FIRST LESSON

Malachi 4

*Look! The day is coming, burning like a blast furnace. All the arrogant and every evildoer will be stubble. The day that is coming will set them on fire, says the LORD of Armies, a day that will not leave behind a root or branch for them. <sup>2</sup> But for you who fear my name, the sun of righteousness will rise, and there will be healing in its wings. You will go out and jump around like calves from the stall. <sup>3</sup> You will trample the wicked. They will surely be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day when I take action, says the LORD of Armies. <sup>4</sup> Remember the law of my servant Moses, which I commanded to him at Horeb to serve as statutes and judgments over all Israel.*

*<sup>5</sup> Look! I am going to send Elijah the prophet to you before the great and fearful day of the LORD comes! <sup>6</sup> He will turn the hearts of fathers to their children and the hearts of children to their fathers. Otherwise, I will come and strike the land with complete destruction.*

2 Thessalonians 1:5-10

*<sup>5</sup> This is evidence of God's righteous verdict that resulted in your being counted worthy of God's kingdom, for which you also suffer. <sup>6</sup> Certainly, it is right for God to repay trouble to those who trouble you, <sup>7</sup> and to give relief to you, who are troubled along with us. When the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his powerful angels, <sup>8</sup> he will exercise vengeance in flaming fire on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. <sup>9</sup> Such people will receive a just penalty: eternal destruction away from the presence of the Lord and from his glorious strength, <sup>10</sup> on that day when he comes to be glorified among his saints, and to be marveled at among all those who have believed, because our testimony to you was believed.*

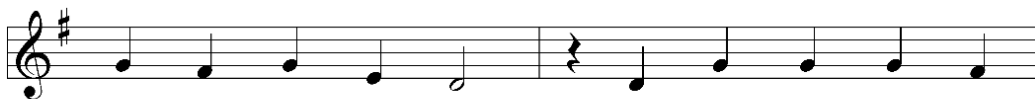

They will put some of you to death. <sup>17</sup> You will be hated by all people for my name’s sake. <sup>18</sup> But not a hair of your head will perish. <sup>19</sup> By patient endurance you will gain your lives.*

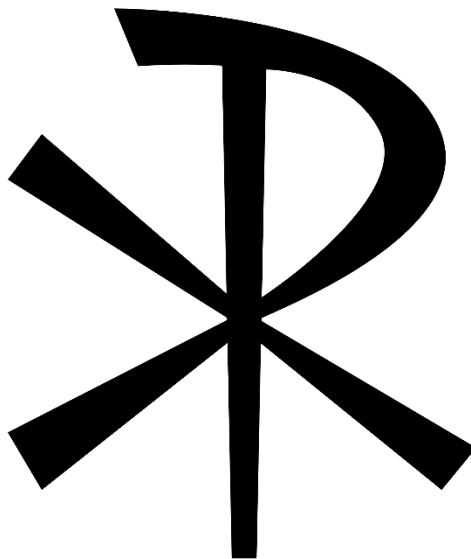
